Chantel has already managed to hit a striking level of maturity and complexity with her appealing music at the age of 24

This charismatic Australian singer, songwriter and pianist creates stunning songs that are inspired by the lush energy of pop and the soulfulness of R&B.

Her dynamic vocal style is very emotional and direct, echoing the work of artists such as Beyonce', Usher or Rihanna, just to mention a few.

Chantel's presence has captured the attention of international renowned artists, managers and labels. Although she hasn't yet been signed, she is fuelled by her passion for music, staying motivated in the process of engaging the right team that will assist her in global achievements and exposure.

A recent highlight for the Australian artist, was Quincy Brown (stepson of P. Diddy) posting her performance of his song "Coming Off Strong" on his Instagram page, to his 4 million followers. She has been featured in the Australian media as one of Australia's "Most Talented". Most recently, she was on the cover of Hustle Mama Magazine, in the USA.

Chantel's passion for music started at a very early age. "She could sing before she could even talk", her dad fondly recalls.

Around the family home, Chantel was introduced to great soul and R&B classics, always singing Mary J Blige, Jackson 5, Michael Jackson, Mario Winans, Luther Vandross and Marvin Gaye, which prominently impacted her approach to music. Ever since the early age of 9, Chantel had determined her ultimate dream - using her God-given talent of singing to connect with a global audience and bring joyfulness and happiness to her listeners.

At the age of 15, Chantel was awarded a scholarship to 'The McDonald College', Australia's leading academic and performing arts school. There, she further developed her musicianship and performance techniques. In 2015, she graduated from Inaburra High School with a 4.0 GPA in Music Theory/ Musicology and Performance.

In 2016, Chantel flew across the world to perform on the prestigious stage of the Premiere Program, held in Orlando, Florida, where she was awarded "Top Vocalist" and "Most Outstanding Performer".

Chantel had already appeared on Disney Channel Australia and New Zealand as a lead actress the previous year, when she performed "The Smart Cookie" on "BF Chefs"... a show about 3 girls who love to spend time together as best friends whilst enjoyably cooking quick and healthy snacks. The show was a success, giving Chantel the opportunity to expose her work to a whole new audience.

In late 2017, Chantel entered the first global competition app, MEGASTAR, in which she placed 1st worldwide in the debut round of the app. She concluded, placing 1st in the Fame Points competition, landing herself an invitation to have a mentoring session with Usher in Los Angeles. Due to external circumstances out of her control, Chantel ended up having a Skype video call with the R&B legend. After hearing her music, Usher commented that he was impressed, said her vocal ability was raw and that he could not fault her voice. They spoke in detail about the music industry, authenticity, improvisation, persistence and the pursuit of perfection.

Following the likes of Quincy Jones, John Mayer, Lalah Hathaway and Charlie Puth, this young rising star was later accepted into the prestigious, Berklee College of Music in Boston Massachusetts as well as The Musicians Institute in Los Angeles.

Chantel's latest performance has startled the nation, currently appearing on season 10 of The Voice Australia. The coaches were left stunned, giving her a 4 chair turn and a standing ovation after she sung her original '2020' for the blind auditions; a song inspired by the Black Lives Movement. With 1.72 million viewers watching that night, her audition has generated plenty of repeated views across all platforms.

This former Disney Channel star is truly a triple threat artist. Not only does she flourish in her vocal and acting abilities, however she also performed and competed in Ballroom dance and Hip-Hop.

There is no doubt it is only a matter of time before Chantel dominates the charts and her fresh take on music thrives to new heights.
